September Stage Shot

Definition

A picture taken in a place of entertainment showing performers. Close - ups of single people are acceptable providing that it can be seen that they are acting a part. Ambient stage lighting should be used (ie no flash).

Additional Information

The challenge here is the utilisation of ambient light only and learning how to shoot moving subjects in low light conditions. The main subject maybe a single performer or a group of performers performing on stage or on the street at any time of day or night. Thespians or musicians are equally acceptable but the performer(s) must be human. In capturing the image greater merit will be awarded to the photographer that chooses to shoot in low light conditions.
