## **2015 Annual Presentation Night**

The Annual Presentation night was held on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July at the Midlands Golf Club. The night was well attended, with approximately 34 occupying the cosy 'Rinks Room'.

Of those present, there were six guests from Geelong Camera Club and four from the local YMCA Camera Group, as well as our well received judge, Janet Rogerson and her mother. Partners of some members also enjoyed the meal and presentation of our work.

Many members commented positively on the appraisals given by Janet Rogerson. Her insightful comments, praise and feedback on how our work could be made even better were well received. Janet is a strong believer in the printed form of photography and believes the photographic journey is complete once the work has been put onto paper.

The amount of prints vs. EDPI were disappointingly low, being well down on those of previous years. Print entries numbered nineteen. EDPI amounted to 85, giving a total entry of 104 images. I think the Club needs to have a discussion on how we can make these numbers more even.

All being said, Janet was impressed with the standard of work and had some tough decisions to make when awarding prizes. The points given on each image were pretty even across all members, with many scoring 12, 13 and 14.

The major prizes went to; "Morgane" by Chris Crossley (EDPI of the year) and "Photographer's Paradise" by Kate Both (Print of the Year). Placings are as the table below.

Lyn Fowler had the biggest surprise of the night, by receiving the David Grigg Recognition Award. This award is selected and given by David himself and this year commended Lyn on her ever improving work as a photographer, as well as her support of the club by regularly submitting images and being on the Committee. Congratulations, Lyn!

Thanks go to the Committee and members who supported the night by helping behind the scenes and attending the function.
