

Ballarat Camera Club Annual Gender Competition

Background

Is it men that take better photo's than women or is it the other way around? Ballarat Camera Club have chosen to address this question and at the same time spice up competition by introducing a "Gender Battle" as part of the monthly competition which will culminate in the announcement of a result and presentation of awards at the annual competition meeting.

Rules

The rules are simple, all photos submitted by all members in all categories throughout the entire year count towards the final result.

Scores for each gender will be tallied monthly with scores being averaged; that is total score divided by the total number of entries. For example: if a total of 32 entries are received in a given month with a combined total score of 341, then the average score would be $341/32 = 10.66$. Scores gained for each month would accumulate towards an annual score.

Entries that are judged as non-acceptances will attract a score of 7. All other entries will be scored as awarded by the monthly judge.

Results

Interim results will be announced at the September meeting, with final results being announced at the Annual Competition meeting. The winning gender will be awarded a perpetual trophy and bragging rights for the next 12 month period. In addition to the announcement and awarding of the "Winning Gender", awards will also be presented to the best contributing male and female.

So which group takes better photos...men or women? Let's find out.
