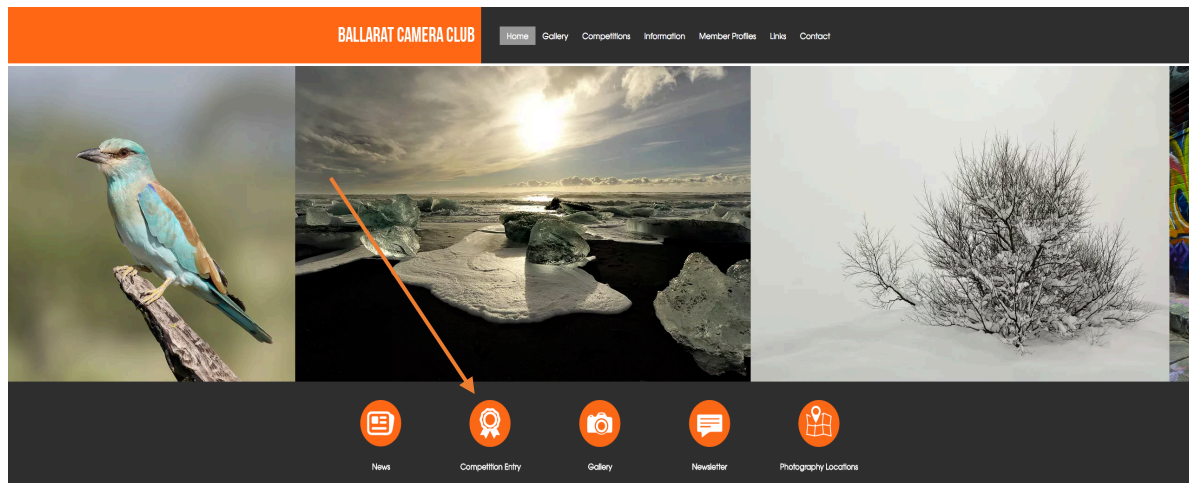


To Reset your Password on BCC

Since its establishment in 1938, members of the Ballarat Camera Club Inc. have encouraged and inspired each other in their photographic pursuits and personal growth.

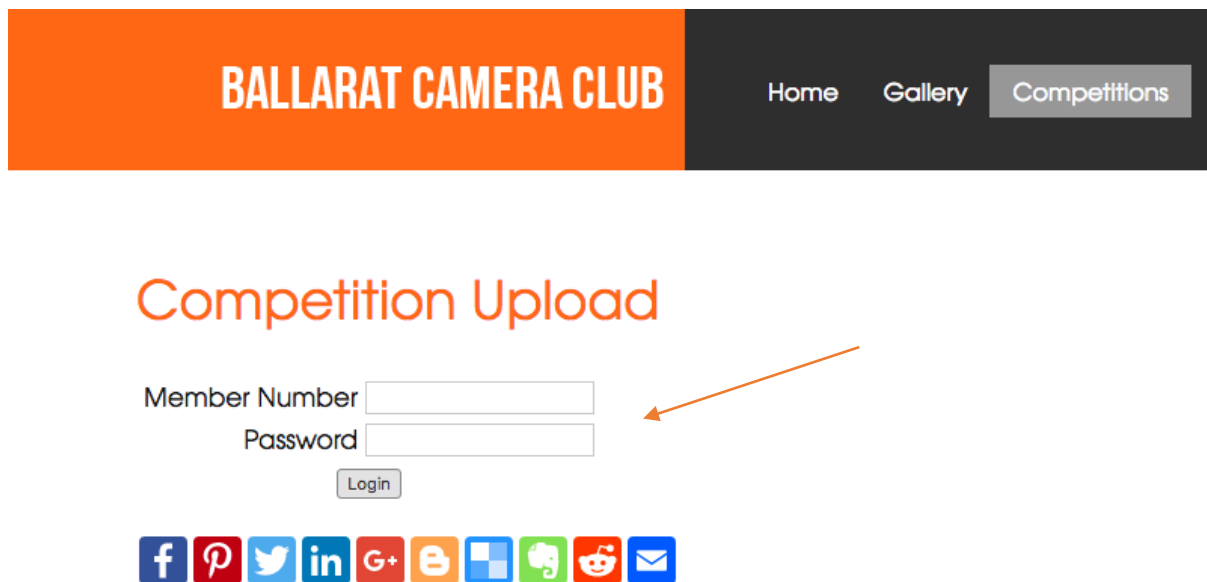
Depending on the needs of members, committee and key club members organise a variety of activities which facilitate the learning of the many aspects of photography.

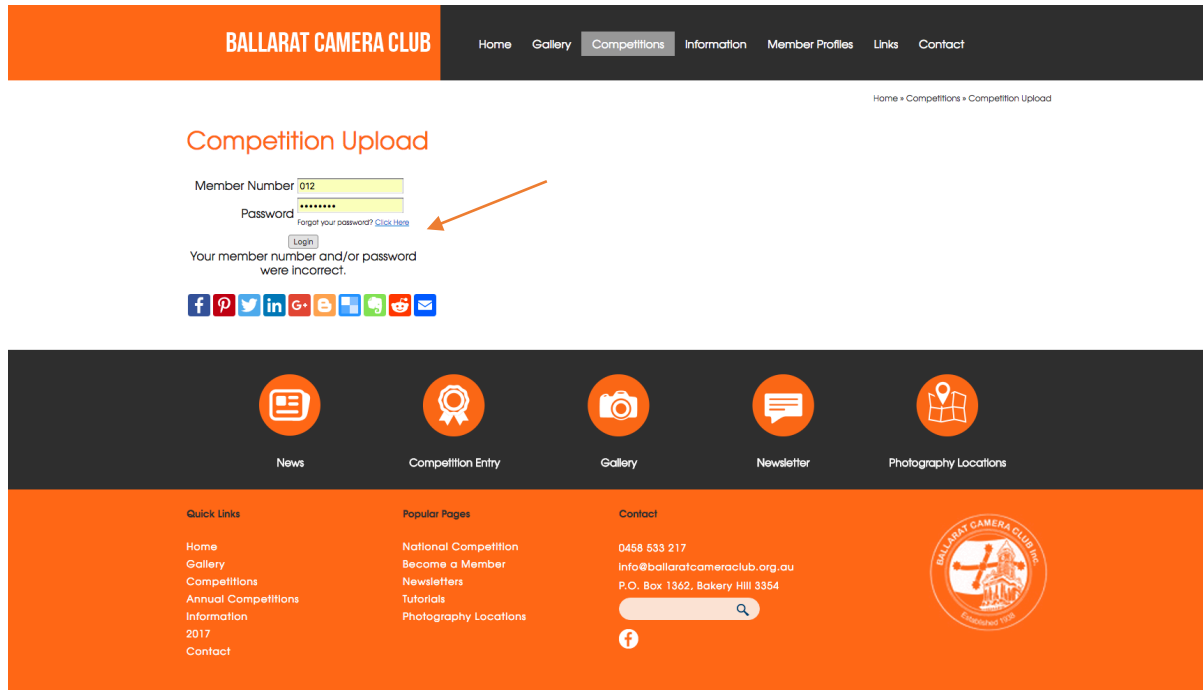

The "Ballarat National Photographic Exhibition" has been proudly run by the Ballarat Camera Club Inc. since 1968. This exhibition is held in high regards

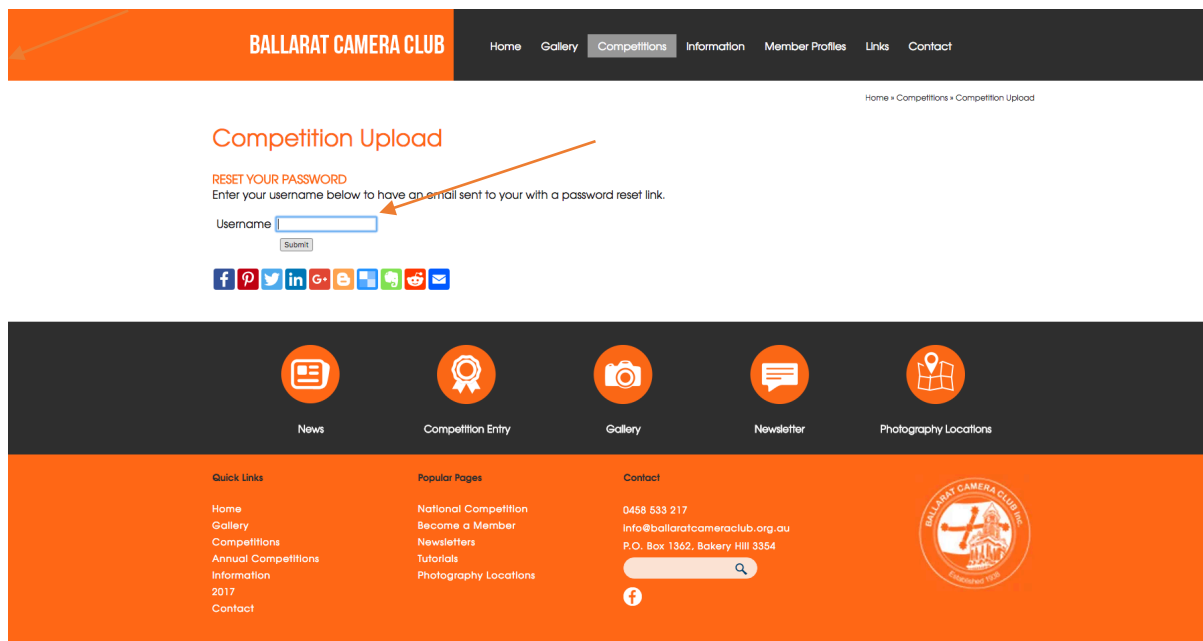
Then type in your Member No and BCC where it says password.



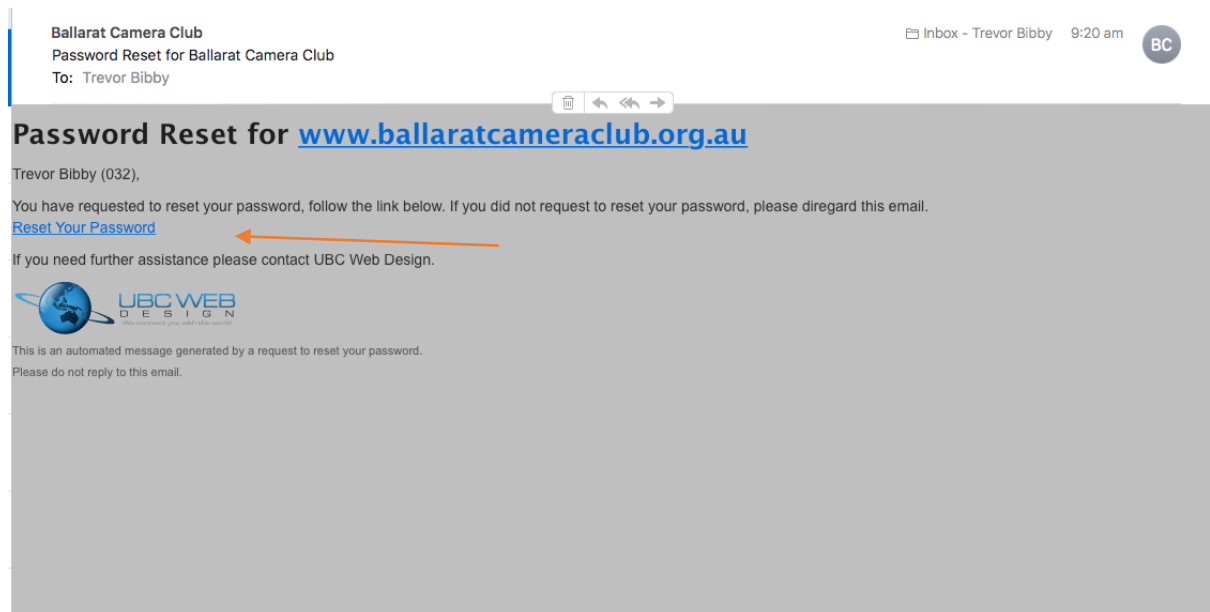
Press Login then where it says “Forgot your password - Click Here”



You will then see this screen

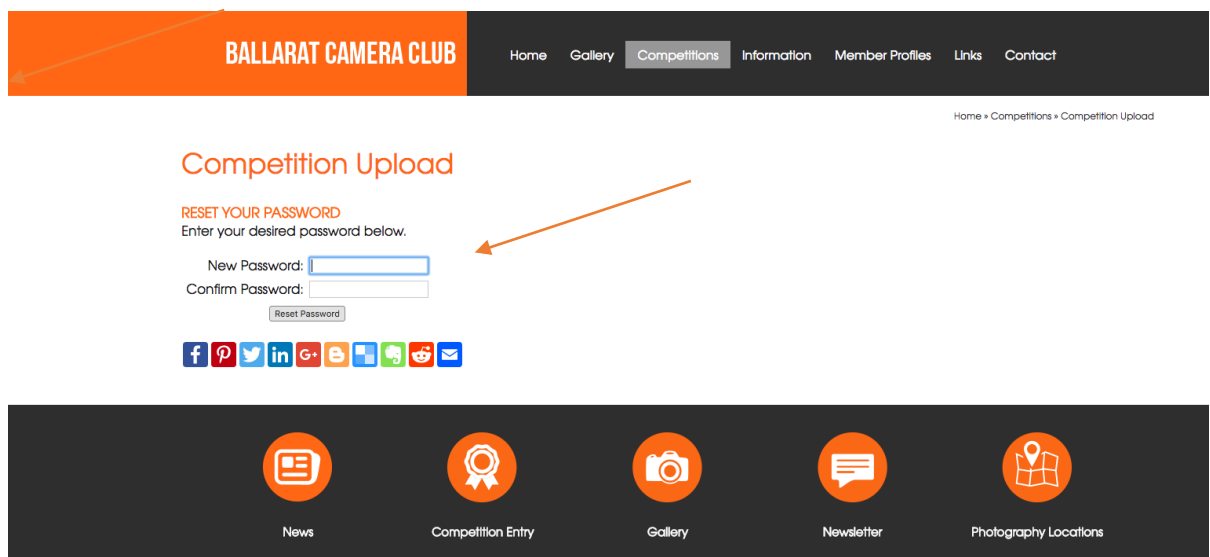


Where it says username put in your **member number** e.g.(012) and click submit, after you do this you will need to check your email and find the email from UBC Design relating to Resetting your password.



Click on the reset password link from your email and it will take you back to the Ballarat Camera Club website.

You will then enter your new password twice as shown on the screen and you will then have your own personal password. Remember that UBC or Ballarat Camera Club will not know your password. It is your responsibility to remember it or you will need to do this procedure again.



You are now ready to upload images for competition with your own password.
